TOXIC CHEMICALS RELEASED BY THE GEORGIA PACIFIC INDUSTRIAL COMPLEX CROSSETT, ARKANSAS. 2011

Within a 24 mile radius there are 36,129 people living in the vulnerable zone, several industrial facilities, public and private elementary and high schools, nursing homes, churches, recreation parks and numerous subdivisions.

- Skin irritations and dermatitis
- Irritation to nose, mouth, throat and lungs
- Asthma-like respiratory problems
- Human cancer causing agents

- Damages lungs
